Monday October 2nd - Arrive at Premier Inn, Canwick. There will be a welcome desk in the hotel entrance for the DGS. An informal get together in Beefeater Restaurant @ 7.00pm. Any food or drinks, to be paid for by each attendee.

Tuesday October 3rd - 9.00am leave hotel for Fillingham Church. We will use Members own cars and will organise lifts for non-drivers. The journey is about 40 mins. The Church will be open to view the Dalton plaque and the Memorials in the Churchyard. I will have copies of the article about the Church and the Memorials which will be in the most recent Journal.

Leave by 10.15am to drive to Knaith, about 8 miles, 20 mins. We will view Knaith Church, where there is another plaque to a Dalton, and meet Mrs & Mr Burke who will talk about the Church and their house, Knaith Hall, the home of Henry Dalton.

When we leave Knaith we will make a stop for lunch on our way back to Lincoln, a venue is being sourced at the moment.

Return to the Hotel and prepare for the AGM at the International Bomber Command Centre. Members can view the Museum, the cost of which is included in the Gathering Conference Fee. It is a very modern, interactive Museum and well worth looking around.
